




This packet includes a board for CentreRock and game piece counters which may be used instead of figures. It also includes a pattern to make a die for use instead of a standard 6 sided die as described in the rules. To assemble your copy of CentreRock, print this packet on a color printer. Cut out the blocks of game pieces and board segments. The board is printed as four quarters that form an 11"x11" board. There is a quarter inch of overlap on each segment. Mount the piece blocks and board segments onto think stock such as chipstock or foamcore board. Spray adhesive works best for this, with rubber cement also performing well. Be sure to align the overlapping board segments properly. Carefully cut out the board and individual game pieces. A hobby knife and metal straightedge work best for this. Enjoy!
















This is an optional die pattern which may be used to assemble your own CentreRock die for use instead of a normal 6 sided die. Cut out the pattern and mount it on thick paper such as posterboard. Spray adhesive and rubber cement work well for this. Carefully cut the pattern out of the thick paper using a hobby knife and straightedge or similar technique. Score each edge, then fold and paste together, using the grey tabs to connect faces. The corner numbers indicate the number of hexes a unit may move for that roll. The icons indicate a successful hit for that unit type. Any attack from the rock for which the face with the gold 3 is rolled is an automatic kill.
